

Hypothesis: Rural areas need to cooperate and complement each other

Needs are increasing qualitatively (and depending on regional demographic developments also quantitatively) and services are increasingly concentrated in urban areas → rural areas must organize collective measures and at the same time maintain a cross-cutting approach → developing services individually is too costly → a global approach based on the regional/inter-municipal planning and pooling of services should be preferred including neighboring territories (valleys, watersheds, intermunicipal structures), combining different services and improving the accessibility of services of general interest
