Resource Abstract	The Alps are one of the most popular recreational spaces in Europe. In this context, this indicator presents an overview of current cultural facilities and opportunities for recreational activities per 1000 inhabitants in the Alpine municipalities. These cultural and recreational facilities include museums, theaters, opera and concert venues, swimming pools, casinos, cinemas, libraries, shopping centres, beer gardens, congress and exhibition centres, sports stadiums, fun parks, parks, zoos, historic sites and major tourist attractions. Selected features in OpenStreetMap which include information on cultural and leisure facilities formed the basis of the data, but make no claim to completeness. Even so, this map gives a good overview of the regional status quo in the provision of cultural and recreational facilities.
