<b>Resource Abstract</b>	The average enterprise size mirrors enterprise density to a large degree. It is not possible to define an optimum size for enterprises: currently the average enterprise size in the secondary and tertiary sector is continually sinking as industrial processes can be organized efficiently even in small units thanks to flexible automation. Transregional markets, however, can only be successfully addressed by enterprises above a certain minimum size. The optimum size of an enterprise is also greatly influenced by its branch of industry or trade.
